Information about the service and availability:

1. The service provides 500 mbps for a current price of \$50 per month, inclusive of all taxes and fees. 500 mbps will provide incredible speed and connectivity.
2. This favorable price has been in effect for several years without an increase. If an entire HOA contracts for the service, a price lock may be available for the length of the contract.
3. Greenlight provides internet service only and has no plans at this time to provide TV or phone services.
4. Installation will require that the fiber optic cable be run underground (at a depth of 4') from the electrical junction box of our buried services to the home. If access roads or driveways are crossed, the area is repaired.
5. The installation fee of \$100 is waived if the homeowner subscribes within 90 days of service availability.
6. The service cannot be suspended and then resumed for snowbirds. However, at this time Greenlight allows users to shut off the service and reconnect later at no charge.
7. Greenlight has an easement agreement from the Town to reach the junction boxes. (HOAs which own property will need to grant Greenlight an easement.)
8. A homeowner may need a new router and perhaps a mesh system to obtain the best utilization of the internet service.
9. If a homeowner has the Spectrum "All-in-One" package and unbundles to substitute Greenlight Internet Service, the overall cost may still be less, depending on whether you keep a landline phone.
10. The projected timeline for when the service might be made available for the neighborhoods in the Tobey Rd. areas is the spring of 2022.
11. Without a subscription to Spectrum internet service, a homeowner cannot use the Spectrum app to access Spectrum TV channels.
12. If a homeowner wants to drop Spectrum cable and stream TV through the internet, there are many streaming services available with different costs and channel lineups.
