1	<p>Boulevard Cypress (51; street side)  <i>Chamaecyparis pisifera</i> 'Boulevard'                      12' x 8' - medium growth rate                      Full sun; loamy, well-drained soil Easy care;                      deer resistant Easy to prune; Blue</p>	
2	<p>Hinoki Cypress – dwarf (7)  <i>Chamaecyparis obtuse</i> 'Nana Lutea'                      4' x 4' - very slow growth rate                      Full sun; Moist, well-drained soil                      Easy care; deer resistant                      Easy to prune; deep green</p>	
3	<p>Hinoki Cypress (30; 67)  <i>Chamaecyparis obtuse</i> 'Nana Gracilis'                      6' x 4' - Moist, well drained soil                      Easy care; deer resistant                      Easy to prune; deep green</p>	
4	<p>Russian Cypress (Arborvitae)                      (between 66 &amp; 67)  <i>Microbiota decussata</i>                      12" x 15' - medium growth rate                      Full/part sun; well-drained soil                      Easy care; deer resistant                      Easy to prune; bright green; bronze in winter</p>	
5	<p>Spreading Juniper (4; island at 51-56)  <i>Juniperus x pfizerina</i>                      5' x 10' - slow growth rate                      Full sun; tolerant of heavy soil                      Easy care; deer resistant                      Easy to prune; blue, grayish green needle</p>	
6	<p>Dwarf White Pine (49; 66) <i>Pinus strobus</i> 'Nana'                      7' x 6' - medium growth rate Full sun/ some shade;                      fertile, well drained soil                      Easy care; deer resistant                      Easy to prune; bluish green</p>	
7	<p>*Dwarf Mugo Pine - <i>Pinus mugo</i> 'Mops'                      3' x 3' - slow rate of growth                      Full/part sun; deep, moist loamy soil                      Easy care; deer resistant                      Medium to dark green</p>	



8	<p>Bird's Nest Spruce (9)  Picea abies 'Nidiformis'  4' x 4' - slow growth rate  Full/partial sun; average soil if moist  Easy care; deer resistant  Easy to prune; dark green</p>	
<b>EVERGREEN SHRUBS WITH LEAVES &amp; FLOWERS</b>		
9	<p>*Mountain Laurel- Kalmia latifolia,  broadleaved evergreen shrub in the heather family,  deer resistant. Blooms late spring &amp; early summer  7-15' tall &amp; spreads to 7-15' at maturity  Shade tolerant, like moist well drained  acidic soil. Prune once flowers fade.</p>	
10	<p>Ilex Crenata (island across from 55)  Japanese Steeds Holly  Alternative to Boxwood  Densely branched evergreen shrub with pyramidal  form. Lustrous dark green foliage. Deer resistant.  6-8 ft. tall, 5-6 ft. wide</p>	
11	<p>Inkberry-(14;48) Ilex glabra, Alternative to Boxwood  5-8' tall, slow-growing. Full sun, acidic moist soil with  good drainage. These plants have both male &amp; female  flowers, so plant both varieties if you want the plants  to produce berries. Upright-rounded, stoloniferous,  broadleaf evergreen shrub in the holly family.  Deer resistant, but not deer proof  Glossy green leaves; white flowers</p>	
12	<p>*Dwarf cotoneaster-Cotoneaster apiculatus (61)  'Tom Thumb' or 'Little Gem'  12" x 3' - Slow rate of growth  Full/part sun; moist well-drained soil but adaptable  Easy care; deer resistant. Easy to prune;  dark glossy green leaves; pinkish flowers; red berries</p>	




13	<p>Pieris-(23; 68) Pieris japonica, several varieties  9' x 6' - slow growth rate  Partial shade; dappled sun; moist, acid, well-drained  soil new growth Easy care; deer resistant Easy to prune;  glossy bronze; green in summer; white or pink flowers</p>	
14	<p>Rhododendron (67) (formerly R. roseum)  8' x 8' - medium growth rate  Sun/part shade; moist, organic-rich, well drained soil  Easy care; deer will eat flower buds in some locations  Easy to prune; carefully remove blossoms when faded  Dark green leaves; bright pink flowers</p>	










15	<p>Rhododendron (island after bridge)</p> <p>Rhododendron catawbiense 'Cunningham White'</p> <p>4' x 4' - medium growth rate</p> <p>Sun/part shade; moist, organic-rich, well drained soil</p> <p>Easy care; deer will eat flower buds in some locations</p> <p>Easy to prune; carefully remove blossoms when faded</p> <p>Dark green leaves; pink buds open to white</p>	
16	<p>* Rhododendron (dwarf)</p> <p>Rhododendron yakusimagnum 'Yaku Princess'</p> <p>3' x 3' - medium growth rate</p> <p>Sun/part shade; moist, organic-rich, well drained soil</p> <p>Easy care; deer may eat flower buds in some locations</p> <p>Easy to prune; carefully remove blossoms when faded</p> <p>Dark green leaves; light pink buds, white flowers</p>	

#### DECIDUOUS SHRUBS WITH FLOWERS

17	<p>Fothergilla (68)</p> <p>Fothergilla gardenia</p> <p>3' x 3' - slow growth rate</p> <p>Full/part sun; well-drained soil</p> <p>Easy care; deer resistant. Easy to prune; green leaves in summer, brilliant yellow, orange, scarlet in fall; white bottle-brush shaped flowers, honey scented</p>	
18	<p>*Common Lilac</p> <p>Syringa vulgaris, many varieties</p> <p>15' x 12' – medium growth rate Full sun; Neutral soil, supplement with peat. Medium care; deer resistant</p> <p>Prune as needed; flowers should be cut off when faded</p> <p>Dark green leaves; lilac flowers; very fragrant</p>	

19	<p>* Korean Lilac (46,32)</p> <p>Syringa patula 'Miss Kim'</p> <p>6' x 6' - slow growth rate-Full/partial sun; loose, well-drained soil. Medium care; deer resistant</p> <p>Prune after flowering; dark green leaves; lavender to ice blue flowers; fragrant</p>	
20	<p>Korean Spice Viburnum (65, rear) Viburnum carlesii</p> <p>Full to partial sun; well-drained, slightly acid soil</p> <p>Easy care; deer resistant</p> <p>Prune after flowering if needed; dull green leaves in summer turning wine red in fall; flowers pink in bud opening white; very fragrant</p>	
21	<p>Doublefile Viburnum (57)</p> <p>Viburnum plicatum var. tomentosum</p> <p>8' x 9' medium growth rate</p> <p>Full/partial sun; demands moist, well drained soil; will not tolerate clay soil Medium care; deer resistant</p> <p>Prune to control ratty appearance; can be pruned to 12" from the ground to rejuvenate. Green leaves turning purple in the fall; white flowers; cascading habit of growth</p>	

22	<p>Viburnum Arrowwood (island at 1-4) <i>Viburnum dentatum</i>  8' x 6' or larger - medium growth rate  Full/partial sun; adapts to various soils Easy care;  deer resistant. Prune to restrict getting out of bounds  Dark green leaves turning yellow to reddish purple;  creamy white flowers; dark blue berries; loved by birds</p>	
23	<p>Viburnum Allegheny (electric box at 67)  Stately, richly textured shrub with deep green leaves  that are practically evergreen most winters.  Spring white bloom.  Full to partial sun; Deer resistant</p>	
24	<p>Weigela florida,  several varieties 6' x 9' - medium growth rate  Full sun; well-drained soil; very adaptable  Medium care; deer resistant, Prune after flowering to  keep in shape Medium green leaf;  white, pink or red flowers</p>	
<b>ORNAMENTAL FLOWERING TREES</b>		
25	<p>Dogwood (14, side)  <i>Cornus florida</i> Rutgers hybrid, 'Stella Pink' &amp; 'Stella White'  20' x 15' - medium growth rate. Partial shade  - acid, well-drained soil with sufficient organic matter  Easy care; deer resistant. Occasional discrete pruning  when mature The Rutgers hybrids are not susceptible to  anthracnose disease. Dark green leaves in summer, red to  purple in fall; pink or white flowers depending on variety</p>	
26	<p>Kousa Dogwood (36, side) <i>Cornus kousa</i>  20' x 20' - slow growth rate  Full/partial sun; well-drained soil w/ organic matter.  Easy care; deer resistant. Occasional discrete pruning  when mature Dark green leaves in summer, red to  purple in fall; creamy white flowers;  red fruit (can be messy when it falls)</p>	
27	<p>Star Magnolia-(small: 45; island at 36-39) <i>Magnolia stellata</i>  20' x 15' or larger - slow rate of growth Full sun/light shade;  moist, deep, acid soil supplemented with peat  Medium care; deer resistant. Occasional discrete pruning  when mature and maybe cabling large limbs. Dark green  leaves in summer often yellow to bronze in fall;  white flowers; fragrant</p>	
28	<p>Serviceberry (4)- <i>Amelanchier arborea</i>  25' x 20' - medium rate of growth  Full/part sun; many types of soil  Easy care; moderately deer resistant, Rarely needs pruning  Medium to dark green leaves in summer; yellow,  apricot, orange, red in fall; purplish black berries</p>	



29	<p>Seven-sons tree (30) - <i>Heptacodium miconioides</i>  20' x 10' - slow growth rate  Sun to part sun - average soil  Easy care; deer resistant - Requires no pruning  Green leaves; white flowers; peeling bark</p>	
30	<p>Styrax - American Snowbell (30) <i>Styrax americanus</i>  8' x 6' - Medium growth rate  Full or part shade; acid, well-drained soil  supplemented with peat moss or organic matter  Easy care; deer resistant - Easy to prune  Bright green leaves, white bell-shaped</p>	
<b>ORNAMENTAL NON-FLOWERING TREES</b>		
31	<p>Japanese Maple (18, rear) <i>Acer palmatum</i>  25' x 25'+, slow rate of growth Dappled shade; moist,  high organic matter, well-drained soil  Easy care; deer resistant-Occasional discrete pruning when  mature Green or purple in summer becoming bronze,  purple or red in the fall</p>	
32	<p>Japanese Maple (small specimen tree) (11, 63, 64)  <i>Acer palmatum dissectum</i> 8' x 8'  Slow rate of growth Full/partial sun; moist, high organic  matter, well-drained soil, Easy care; deer resistant  Occasional discrete pruning when mature. Green or  purple depending on variety  (green leaf varieties turn yellow-gold to red in fall)</p>	
33	<p>Paperbark Maple - (66) <i>Acer griseum</i> 30' x 15'  Slow rate of growth  Full sun; well-drained moist soil but is adaptable  Easy care; deer resistant, Occasional discrete pruning  when mature Bluish green leaves in summer  changing to bronze or russet-red in fall</p>	
<b>EVERGREEN TREES</b>		
34	<p>Swiss Stone Pine (island at 57-62) <i>Pinus cembra</i>  40' x 25' - slow rate of growth  Full sun; well-drained loamy, slightly acid soil  Easy care; deer resistant  Rarely needs pruning; dark green needles</p>	
35	<p>Western Arborvitae (50, side)  <i>Thuja standishii</i> x <i>plicata</i> 'Green Giant'  70' x 25'- fast rate of growth, easy care  deer resistant (so far). No pruning necessary  but a light trim any time of year will encourage  dense growth Green in summer, slightly bronzy in winter</p>	
36	<p>* Chinese Juniper  2-40' tall x 15-20' wide  Soil: moist, well drained - Bloom time=Spring  Yellow to bronze flower(no ornamental value)</p>
