

Rosepark's Kayak Rack Policy

May - 2016

At present there are 4 kayak racks providing 28 spots to store kayaks lakeside.

The racks are to be used by residents and their immediate family members only. Spots will be assigned with first consideration given to personal needs followed by individual preferences. Spots will be labeled with the owner's name. No unassigned kayaks will be permitted in the racks or on the ground. Contact a member of the kayak committee to request an assigned spot on one of the racks.

The following stipulations must be met for kayak storage:

- 1- Owner's name must be printed legibly on the kayak with black permanent marker.*
- 2- Kayaks must be secured and locked to prevent loss or possible injury to others using the racks.*
- 3- Kayaks stored on the racks are done so at the owner's risk and are the full responsibility of the owner.*
- 4- Kayaks can only be stored in the owner's assigned spot(s).*
