The following was emailed and mailed to those with no email on 10/8/2020.

It was brought to my attention that there were some recent radon tests in the Coastal View development that came back high. Radon is a naturally-occurring radioactive gas that can be harmful and cause lung cancer. Radon gas is inert, colorless and odorless. Radon gas becomes trapped indoors after it enters buildings through cracks and other holes in the foundation. Indoor radon can be controlled through an **Indoor Air Quality** expert.
