EDGEWOOD ESTATES HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION SATELLITE DISH VARIANCE ADDENDUM

These guidelines apply to all satellite dish installations. This Addendum shall be signed and submitted with the variance request to Crofton Associates. The Board of Directors shall review all requests. Depending on the monthly board meeting, responses will provided within 30 days. This variance for installation of the dish applies only to the submitting owner of the unit. The dish shall be removed upon sale of the unit by the satellite dish company at the sellers' expense unless the seller provides the board with written consent from the new owner accepting the obligations and responsibilities.

The homeowner shall provide the location by a means of a sketch or picture. The type of mounting bracket to be used, the company name, address, telephone number and contact person shall be provided. The homeowner shall request and provide written confirmation that a signal can be obtained at the selected location.

- 1. The preferred location is on the homeowner's deck as listed in the rules and regulations on page 13. If the dish company is unable to obtain a signal from that location, the homeowner will need to contact the board of directors for review/approval of an alternative location.
- 2. The Homeowner shall install no more than one satellite dish, the size of which shall not exceed 18". This dish shall be properly grounded and external cable shall be neatly installed and hidden from view as much as possible. The installation shall comply with federal, state and town regulations and codes. The dish shall be installed by a professional satellite dish installer and/or company. Homeowner shall obtain a copy of the installer's liability insurance.
- 3. The homeowner shall be responsible for any damage caused to the structure or common area during installation of the dish. The homeowner shall also be responsible for any damage caused by the dish to the property or a person. For example, windstorm tears off the dish, damage the structure or common area, the homeowner shall be liable. This includes lightening strikes.
- 4. The homeowner shall be responsible for repairs or problems to the mounted dish location caused by the installation or associated mounting of the satellite dish. Certain mounted locations will require that repairs be conducted by the association's designated contractor. At no time shall a homeowner climb on or atop the exterior of their units.
- 5. If the installed dish is on any part of the structure maintained by the Association and maintenance is required to the area, the homeowner shall be responsible for removal and reinstallation of the dish. If the homeowner does not remove the dish, the association may do so at homeowner expense. The Association shall not be liable for any damage or reinstallation of the dish.
- 6. Permanent removal of the dish requires restoration of the location to its original condition by the homeowner at their expense. Some locations may require restoration at the homeowner's expense by the association's designated contractor when structure warranties are involved.
- 7. The homeowner shall indemnify and hold the Edgewood Estates Homeowners Association harmless for injury or damage caused by dish at installation, removal, replacement and duration of installed dish.
